The Grade II listed building originally housed Barton upon Humbers thriving rope making industry during the 18th Century. Originally constructed in 1767 the Ropewalk is claimed to be the longest listed building with a tiled roof in Europe.

Extensive upgrading, conversion and enhancement works undertaken by Britcon converted the building to a Arts Heritage Centre comprising training rooms, gallery, workshops and associated facilities the development was made possible through funding from The European development Fund, Barton Single Regeneration Budget, Yorkshire Forward and The Proudfoot Group.
