

Britcon UK Ltd Carbon Policy Statement and Commitment to Sustainable Development

Climate Change Act 2008

As part of Britcon (UK) Ltd.'s Strategy we want to play our part in compliance with UK Legislation, contributing to the UK's targets of cutting greenhouse gases by 34% and 80% by 2020 and 2050 respectively, against 1990 levels.

Britcon Targets

We've set a target to reduce our absolute operational carbon emissions by 20% by 2020 and 80% by 2050, decoupling our environmental impacts from business growth.





Our carbon management strategy involves:

- Measuring and reporting our carbon footprint
- Setting targets for reducing our absolute carbon emissions
- Minimising our emissions by improving operational efficiencies and investing in technological innovation
- Working with our suppliers to understand the opportunities to improve our supply chain footprint
- Sharing our knowledge of carbon accounting, management and reporting from our client work and operational experiences across our networks to accelerate best practice
- Encouraging and helping our people to reduce the emissions they generate in their working lives
- Buying energy from renewable sources whenever practicable

The way we are to achieve this is by engaging with ConstructCo2 with an initial small number of sites, which will gauge what progress we can make over the coming years.

We will measure the whole company footprint by August 2017 and then set the targets from there, these are expected to be a reduction on our carbon footprint of 20% by 2020 and then 80% by 2050.

Britcon (UK) Ltd Directors are committed to this target and have signed below to show their commitment and to meet periodically to review this policy.
